## RECYCLING GUIDE:

# Blue Bins

### YES:

- Newspapers, white/colored office paper (staples are okay)
- Corrugated cardboard
- Paper bags
- Glass bottles/jars (i.e. wine bottles, food containers, etc.)
- All metal cans (i.e. aluminum & steel)
- Plastic containers #1 and #2 (i.e. milk jugs, water bottles, shampoo, etc.)



### NO:

- Magazines, glossy paper, envelopes, tape, stick on labels, rubber bands, or shredded paper
- Drinking glasses, ceramics, window glass, lightbulbs
- Styrofoam, plastic tubs, plastic bags, plastic toys

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- Deposit all items loose into blue trash bins
  - Rinse all plastic containers/bottles and remove lids/caps
    - Labels are okay
    - Break down cardboard boxes
  - All items must fit in the bins with the lid closed

## RECYCLING GUIDE:

# Green Bins

### YES:

- Grass clippings
- Tree and hedge trimmings (i.e. branches, leaves, etc.)
- Garden fruits and vegetables
- Christmas trees
- Organic materials

### NO:

- Ornaments, tinsel, or flocking
- Bags
- Pet waste

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- Deposit all items loose into green trash bins
  - All items must fit in the bins with the lid closed
    - Cut branches and other foliage down
  - All organic materials in bins will be composted

## RECYCLING GUIDE:

### *Green Bins*

#### YES:

- Grass clippings
- Tree and hedge trimmings (i.e. branches, leaves, etc.)
- Garden fruits and vegetables
- Christmas trees
- Compostable items

#### NO:

- Ornaments, tinsel, or flocking
- Bags
- Plastics are not compostable

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- Deposit all items loose into green trash bins
  - All items must fit in the bins with the lid closed
    - Cut branches and other foliage down
